
External crossing equipment at Columbus Avenue, MP 12.98 Kenton Line has been retired.


The following Operational Procedures will be utilized at this location when necessary to test or disable automatic warning devices.

## **Testing of Automatic Warning Devices:**

When necessary to test automatic warning devices at this location, utilize the following procedure:

Open XR Positive (Gold Nut) labeled Maintainer Test Switch located above CCU-1.



## When Automatic Warning Devices are to be Disabled:

- Ensure protection is provided with the Train Dispatcher on all tracks.
- Open XR Positive (Gold Nut) labeled Maintainer Test Switch.
- Open XR Negative (Gold Nut) labeled Maintainer Test Switch N.
- Apply (RED) Positive Jumper from CCU Terminal Equipment Battery + to CCU Control Terminal +
- Apply (BLACK) Negative Jumper from CCU Terminal Equipment Batter to CCU Control Terminal –



<u>NOTE</u>: The crossing remains Disabled, as prescribed in GCOR 6.32.2, Automatic Warning Devices until all components have been reported to normal operation and the Train Dispatcher has been notified
