

## TRANSPORTATION - CLERICAL NOTICE #2020-C008

**To:** All Concerned, Transportation – Clerical Employees

## **Subject: Hazardous Material Documentation - Clerical Responsibilities**

Each train departing Clearing with hazardous materials entrained must do so with proper documentation, as prescribed in Section 2 of the BRC Hazardous Materials Instructions, HM-1.

The Chief Clerk is responsible for assuring the required items on each outbound train list generated at Clearing.

- Errors with outbound paperwork or shipping descriptions must be resolved prior to the train departing.
- Verify the following information with the Yardmaster and by direct observation of the paperwork generated to assure correct outbound documentation:
  - o Standing order of cars in the train, and train make up is correct.
  - If a placement error is identified, it must be reviewed with the Yardmaster and corrected.
- Notify the Yardmaster and Terminal Manager, with a copy email top the Director of Car Operations and Project Management.
- Trains may not depart with hazardous materials placement violations.
- Where information was not available from Belt Apps, or the EDI 418 message was not available, assure that the proper information: EDI 404, EDI 417, or waybill was received from the inbound carrier and correct the documentation.

- When necessary to correct outbound train documentation by hand, your initials and date must be shown next to any handwritten notations.
- o When updates are necessary, ensure the crew departs with the correct documentation.
- When necessary to make a manual update to outbound documentation, send an email to the Director of Car Operations and Project Management prior to going off duty documenting the occurrence and what was done.
