Track Laborer

The Belt Railway Company of Chicago is currently accepting applications for Track Laborers. Will work as a member of a crew to maintain, repair and replace ties, switches, rails and ballast, using hand tools and hand operated equipment. Uses Rail Saw to cut rail to specified lengths. Drills holes through rails for insertion of bolts using hand or power drill. Uses spike maul or jack hammer to drive spike into tie and secure rail. Uses track wrench to tighten or loosen bolts at joints that hold ends or rails together. Shifts are variable, and dependent upon seniority, and workers must be available and on-call for overtime calls 24/7, including weekends and holidays. Experience in welding, electrical or mechanical work or heavy equipment operation a plus. Must be able to work in a safety-sensitive, construction-oriented environment. Class A CDL strongly preferred, or candidate must demonstrate ability to obtain one within 90 days. Must have experience working outside and have own vehicle. Must have a HS diploma or GED and valid driver's license. Must be able to work on a full-time basis. pass a physical and background check, as well as a post-offer drug test if offered a position.
