Locomotive Engineer

The position is represented by The Brotherhood of Locomotive Engineers and Trainmen (BLET), with initiation and monthly dues required.

You will be on-call twenty-four (24) hours a day, seven (7) days a week. Includes weekends and holidays. Must be available to report on approximately 2 hours' notice. (You should consider the long-term effect of the above lifestyle on your personal and/or domestic situation.)

SUMMARY OF REQUIREMENTS AND ESSENTIAL FUNCTIONS:

2+ years of stable employment experience
1+ years of experience in railroad operations
State-Accredited High School Diploma or G.E.D. required
The work is outdoors; exposed to all types of weather conditions.
There is a probationary period.
Must be eligible to work in the U.S.
Must be able to meet CFR 240 (Engineer Certification) hearing and vision requirements
Must not have any CFR 240 or 242 revocation events in the last three years.
Motor vehicle driving record that meets CFR 240 requirements.
Demonstrate regular and reliable attendance.
Must have excellent prior safety record.

A Locomotive Engineer is responsible for the safe movement of freight trains and switching of cars in BRC's Clearing Yard and our neighboring industries.

DUTIES:

Follow written and verbal directions to complete assigned tasks on schedule.
Conduct locomotive inspections to meet FRA requirements
Read and interpret wayside signals, track bulletins, and railroad rules and regulations
Abide by safety rules and federal regulations.
Coordinate with train dispatcher via radio to issue or receive information on work to be performed.
May assist coworkers in performing switching operations.
May make minor repairs to locomotives and air hoses
Must report any equipment requiring major repairs.
Performs other duties as requested or required
