3001-A	ADDITIONAL SERVICE VIA BRC	<p><b>RE-HUMPS</b></p> <p><b>TEMPORARY RE-HUMP CHARGE</b></p> <p>Notwithstanding the rate structure set forth in Section 1 and Section 2 of BRC 8002-S, and notwithstanding Item 3001 of Freight Tariff BRC 8002-S, any switching move which requires more than one hump event to be subsequently interchanged to the destination carrier shall be and assessed an additional charge per “Re-hump” event of \$150.00 per car, discounted from the BRC 3001 charge of \$250.00.</p> <p>This temporary charge applies only to re-hump events occurring from July 1, 2026 through July 31, 2026, inclusive. Upon expiration of this Item 3001-A, the re-hump charge published in Item 3001 of Freight Tariff BRC 8002-S shall apply without further action.</p> <p>This charge is applicable and in addition to all contractual arrangements, unless otherwise specified.</p>	<b>\$150.00</b>
